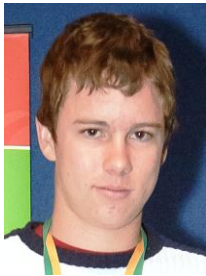

Achieved the Club's highest batting aggregate. Achieved rare match double of century and 5 wickets vs Bald Hills Lawnton 15 Roar



### **Ben Whitmore** (U15 Green) – Runner-up - Player of the Year (U13-17 Div.) – 844 points

## **FDCC President's Report 2010/2011**

### **The Season that Was:**

Rain, rain, rain and more rain. That is what greeted us for our 2010/2011 season and continued for most of it. It started on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the season with it being washed out completely. The 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend was not much better with many games again washed out but for those that dared to play it will long live in our memories as one of the most windy and freezing cold days on a cricket field you would ever want to experience.

The weather continued to disrupt many more weekends but this was insignificant to the flooding we first saw in the north and then in our own city and surrounds in December and January. The north copped it again with Cyclone Yasi. It was a summer where nature was telling us to not mess with it and who was really in control.

Despite these disruptions, the club again performed exceptionally well with many outstanding team and individual performances some of which are highlighted as follows.

- The club came 4<sup>th</sup> out of 11 clubs in the Brisbane North Club Championship, just missing out for 3<sup>rd</sup> place. We came 3<sup>rd</sup> in the previous two seasons. Nevertheless it represents a continuing all-round solid performance by all our teams.
- The U15 Green full season team had an outstanding season winning the premiership. Congratulations to all the players and volunteers who all contributed to this result.
- 15 teams, 7 junior and 8 senior competed in the Brisbane North Zone competition. This equated to 180 registered players across all age groups from U8 to U17.
- The In2Cricket program co-ordinated by Andrew Middleton continued to be very popular with 80 grade 1, 2, 3, 4ers participating in fun skilled based activities. Thanks to Andrew and his team of helpers.
- 10 Ferny Players were selected in BNJCA representative teams. Unfortunately in some instances the weather played havoc with these carnivals with some not playing at all.
- Fireball Events:
  - The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Ferny 6's was another successful day with 8 teams from our zone and other zones competing for the winning prize and perpetual trophy. Sandgate Redcliffe was the final winner with our Ferny team being knocked out in the semi-finals. Thanks to Gavin Gleeson for the superb organisation of this event.
  - The Nambour Invitational – unfortunately the wet weather wiped this out for this season

- Trivia Night – This year was a “German Theme” with our long term supporters, the Honeywood Court Jesters re-gaining the title plus winning the best themed decorated and dressed table. Thanks to Geoff Cowles and Warwick Baillie for again pulling this together.

There were many terrific performances from our players during the season, and as much as I don't particularly like singling anybody out as it takes the whole team to enable these to happen, the following deserve special mention.

- Caillan Leader (U15) scored 2 centuries with the most aggregate runs of 396 at a Bradman like average of 99 and was this season's winner of the James Hopes Trophy as the Player of the Year, U13 to 17 Division.
- Ben Whitmore (U15) scored 1 century and took the most wickets for the season of 19 at an average of 8.89. Ben also won 2 Brisbane North Player of the Round Awards and was Runner Up in the Player of the Year Award, U13 to 17 Division.
- Jimmy Futchter (U12) was our Player of the Year, Under 11 & 12 Division and for that received this season's Geoff Foley Trophy. His outstanding bowling effort was 15 wickets at the Club's best average of 4.4.
- Finally after being a runner up twice in these competitions in past seasons Chris Knight (U17) finally won the Half Season Player of the Year Award to cap off a fine junior cricket career with Ferny since U8.
- Josh Lewis (U15) and Craig Pereira (U17) scored a century each.
- Jared Mallit (U15) achieved the best bowling analysis of 6/4 off just 2 overs.
- Zach Hogan (U10) took the bowlers ultimate goal of a hat trick.
- Luke Sciacca (U9) with 60no was the highest individual score in the junior ranks.
- Liam Wilson (U10) had the best individual bowling performance at the junior level with 6/10.
- Jackson Morwood (U10) obviously has a good set of hands plus is a ball magnet taking 17 catches for the season. In the senior ranks Alexander Neil (U15) snared 11 catches.

This season saw our continued involvement with Arana Sports, a not for profit organisation made up of 8 local sporting clubs to promote sports within our local communities. This involvement enables us to increase our coverage within the district as well as give us access to a full time Sports and Recreation officer who can assist us with such things as grant applications, promotional events and advertising. It was pleasing after a probation year that we have now been accepted as a full time member of the organisation. Thank you to the Arana Sports Club committee and members for welcoming us to the group.

With the assistance of Elaine (thanks) from Arana Leagues Club working with Arana Sports, we were successful in obtaining a grant from the Commonwealth Bank Grass Roots of Cricket Program. This saw us receive \$1000 cash, two 3 x 3 portable marquees, 50 field markers and 100 water bottles. As our application was based on a sun safe theme, for the 2011/2012 season we will be using the \$1000 to provide all of our junior players (U8 to U10) with a wide brim sun safe hat as well as a water bottle.

### **The Season to be:**

There were many goals and aspirations which I had at the beginning of the season. My biggest disappointment is that few of these came to fruition. This combined with the potential crisis that cricket in general is facing with competition for participation of our youth, has left me with a bit of an empty feeling in my stomach and a level of dissatisfaction.

So for the forthcoming 2011/2012 season I am suggesting that the newly elected committee not set the bar so high as to what we want to achieve. Let the club go back to basics and concentrate its energies on a select number of core goals. Let us assist all of our fantastic volunteers such that their task is as easy as possible in this time starved world. Let us promote a sense of involvement such that an environment is set that our members can flourish. Let us make it fun to be involved with the Fireballs. Let us ensure that this great game survives its current challengers.
